
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# A THOUSAND WISHES SURROUNDED BY SEA

The tradition and knowledge of generations together with the best produce make each meal a truly memorable occasion.




## WELCOME TO THE GOLDEN ISLAND

## MERCADO DOS LAVRA-DORES

Situated in the centre of Funchal, in the historic neighbourhood of Santa Maria, is one of those amazing places that make us feel like we have known them forever. Welcome to Mercado dos Lavradores, the market that is one of the most famous sights in Madeira, where colours, aromas and tradition join to welcome and amaze visitors.

Built in the 1930s. in a graceful combination of Art Deco and Modernism, this market presents the best the island has to offer: the freshest and most exotic fruit, beautiful flowers from the "Atlantic garden", meat, fish, vegetables and spices of regional origin.







## WICKER TOBOGGANS

#### 10 exhibarating minutes

In Madeira, a fun time can be waiting for you around every corner. If you go up to Monte, you will find one of the most famous attractions in Funchal, a unique experience that you won't want to miss. A truly unique mean of trasportation: the wicker toboggans.

Hand-crafted from wicker and wood, they are controlled by two traditionally dressed drivers. With great skill, they use the thick rubber soles on their boots as brakes.

The ride down to Livramento takes around 10 minutes, with crazy moments of pure excitement for all passengers.







## EMBROIDERY

#### Skill and perfection

The embroideries of Madeira represent hundreds of years of art and tradition, with absolutely astonishing quality and meticulous detail. This is something that can be seen in each piece.

Embroidery was introduced by the Phelps family, who first settled on the island in 1784, and has become part of the islands' culture and history. Madeira embroidery is world renowned and has recently been used by stylists in the world of fashion.

The fabrics used are linen, silk, cotton and organdie.

The designs (on items including tablecloths, dresses, shirts, sheets and handkerchiefs) use traditional and modern patterns.

Once embroidered, each finished item receives a "unique" seal that makes it even more special.





#### From Madeira to the world

The real treasure of the Madeiran economy is also a gift from the islands to the world. And those who have tasted it know what we are talking about.

Madeira Wine is a fortified wine that has been produced for more than five hundred years, from grapes grown on the hillsides of the Madeira wine region. It can be served as an aperitif or after a meal and its flavour and spirit brought it illustrious admirers such as George Washington, Thomas Jefferson and Winston Churchill.

Currently, the grape varieties most widely used to produce Madeira Wine are Sercial (dry), Verdelho (medium-dry), Boal (medium-sweet), Malvasia (sweet) and Tinta Negra (dry, medium-dry, medium-sweet and sweet). However, there are also other recommended and certified varieties.





Suddenly time stops

Is there anything more comforting than a marvellous massage

Is there anything more comforting than a marvellous massage or therapy after a walk in the hills, along the famous "levadas"? In Madeira, whatever you do, there is always time to relax and enjoy the occasion.

Most of the spas are in hotels situated in Funchal, with excellent modern facilities.



## CANYONING


Follow the stream, in the heart of the island

## Exploring without limits

#### A whole ecosystem to discover

The natural wealth of the islands is not limited to their vegetation. Visitors to Madeira islands can observe a wide variety of land and sea birds, some of them quite rare. Zino's petrel or freira, for example, endemic to Madeira and classified as critically endangered, was even thought to be extinct in the 1970s.

Birdwatchers will find excellent observation points for nesting and migratory birds, in various areas classified as biogenetic reserves and world natural heritage. There is a whole ecosystem to discover, a fascinating world of birdwatching potential.
















# INFINITE OCC AS FAR AS THE EYE CAN SEE




### whale WATCHING


With all its qualities, the island of Porto Santo appears to have been blessed. Its splendid seashore and the beauty of its beach make it a ideal destination for water sports lovers.
